

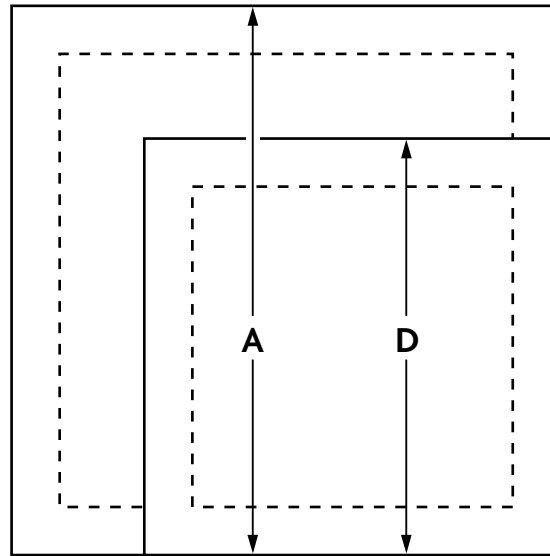


FIVE SPOT BLOCK

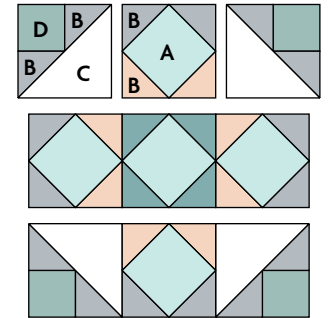
This free 10-inch quilt block pattern got its name from the five squares set on point, which are a perfect place to use a favorite print, like we did here with Alchemy by Shell Rummel for Blend Fabrics, a licensing division of Anna Griffin, Inc.

When multiples of this quilt block are set side by side the on-point squares are linked across the surface of the quilt, creating chains of twinkling diamonds. Try contrasting values for the B patches to highlight different aspects of the design. Heavy starch will prevent the bias edges from stretching while sewing, and with lots of corners to match, you can't be too careful!
