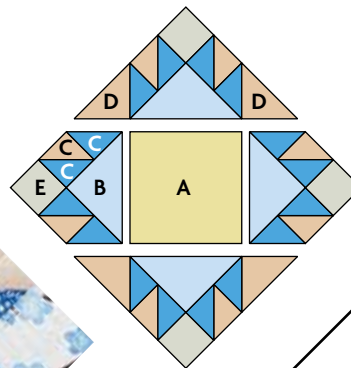
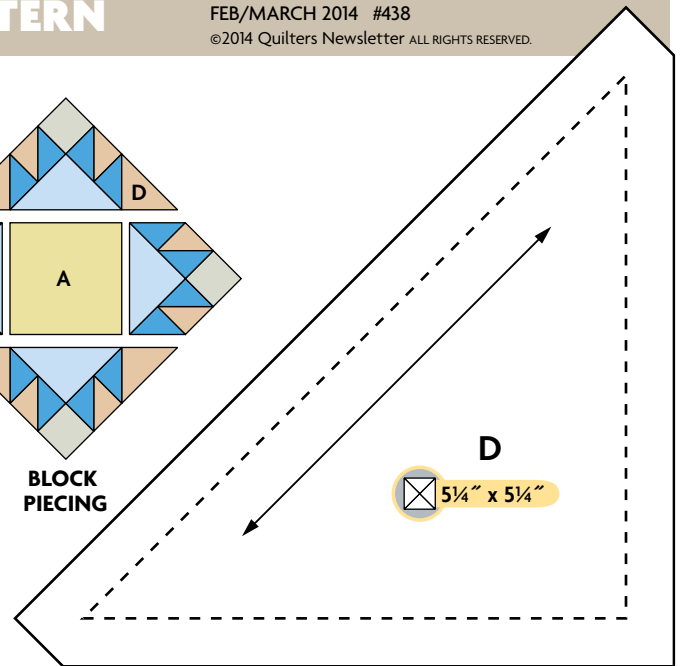


King's Crown

According to Barbara Brackman's *Encyclopedia of Pieced Quilt Patterns*, King's Crown was published by Nancy Page, a syndicated mail-order column written by Florence LaGanke Harris, which appeared in many periodicals in the 1920s-40s.

The A patch is just right to show off a large-scale print, like the Tomo collection by Kona Bay Fabrics that was used in this example. The large center square would also work well for a beautiful quilting motif.

This block also works nicely as the background for an applique. Use a large-scale print and fussy cut for your preferred method of applique. As seen here, the applique does not have to fit in the A patch but can spill over the edges.
