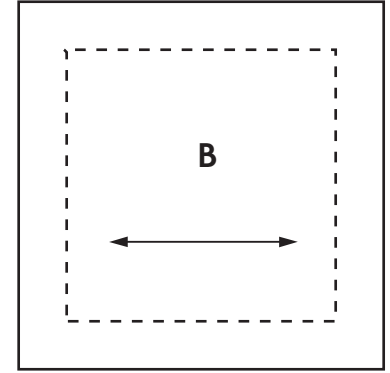
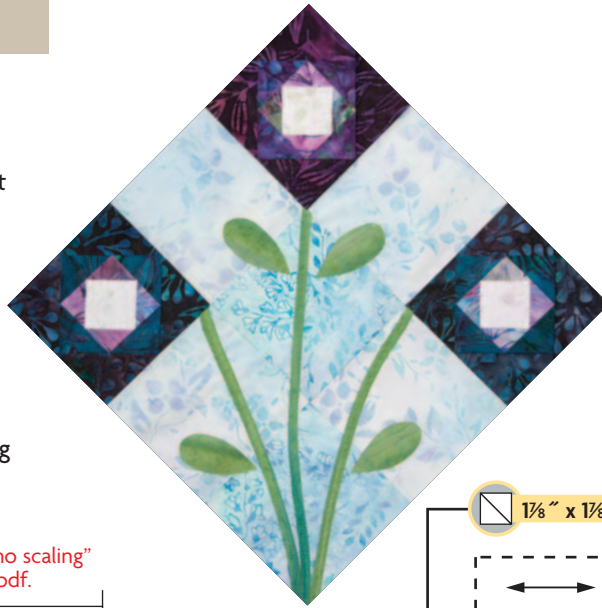


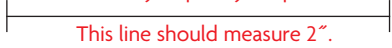
Triple Rose

Triple Rose was first published by Aunt Martha Studios in 1963. Substituting different fabrics can create a totally different look. The blossoms can be foundation pieced or pieced with patches B-E.

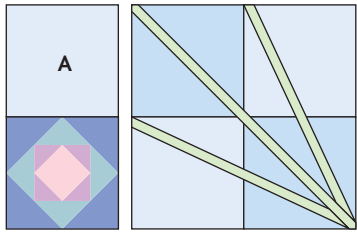
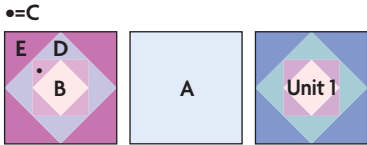
Piece the 3 blossoms first. Join 4 A's and applique three straight-grain 1/4" x 13" stems as shown in the block piecing diagram. Join the remaining A's and blossom units. Applique the leaves.



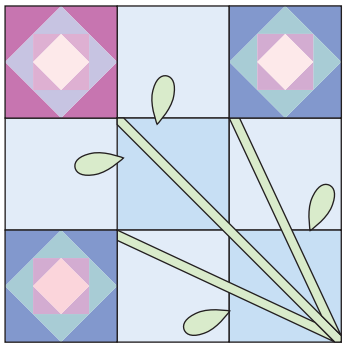
Set your printer to 100% or "no scaling" before you print your pdf.



This line should measure 2".

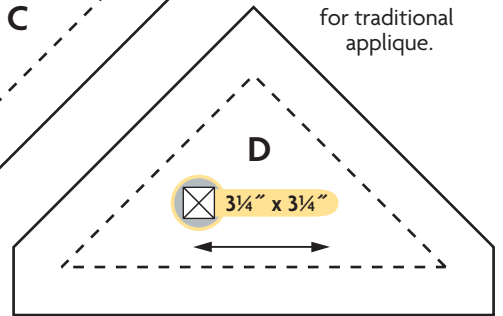
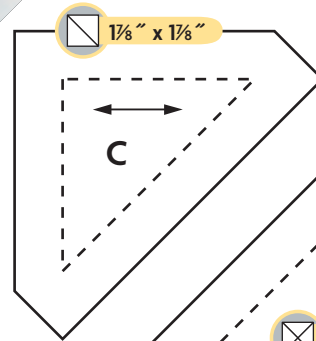
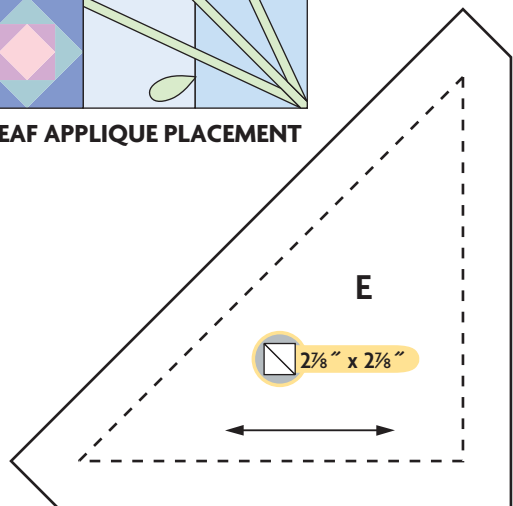


BLOCK PIECING
