Planning

Our instructions are written so each block has 3 fabrics—1 for the star points and block center, 1 for the background, and 1 for the triangles surrounding the center square.



Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)

□ = cut in half twice diagonally
 □ = cut in half diagonally
 Assorted light tan/cream/gray prints, batiks, and dots

cut 30 matched sets of:

2 squares 41/4" x 41/4" 1 square 31/2" x 31/2"

Assorted medium/dark gray/blue batiks, prints, and dots

cut 30 matched sets of:

1 square 41/4" x 41/4" 4 squares 31/2" x 31/2"

cut a total of:

5 squares 15" x 15" 20 squares 9½" x 9½"

2 squares 8" x 8"

Assorted medium/dark brown and gold batiks—cut a total of:

30 squares 41/4" x 41/4"

Dark blue batik

8 strips 21/2" x width of fabric (binding)

Piecing the Blocks

1 Note: The following instructions are for making 1 block. Draw 2 diagonal lines on wrong side of assorted light tan/cream/ gray 41/4" square. Referring to Diagram I-A, place marked square on assorted medium/dark gray/blue 41/4" square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" seam on each side of one line. Cutting on unsewn line first, then on remaining drawn line, cut sewn square into quarters. Open and press to make 4 light/gray/blue pieced triangles. Make 30 sets of 4 matching. In same manner, use assorted medium/dark brown or gold 41/4" square and matching light 41/4" square to make 4 light/brown/gold pieced triangles (Diagram I-B). Make 30 sets of 4 matching.





2 Sew together 1 light/gray/blue pieced triangle and 1 matching light/brown/gold pieced triangle to make star-point unit (Diagram II). Make 30 sets of 4 matching.



Referring to Diagram III and watching orientation, sew 3 rows using 4 matching gray/blue 31/2" squares, 4 star-point units, and 1 matching light 31/2" square. Sew rows together to make Ohio Star Block (Diagram IV). Make 30 total blocks.

Assembling the Quilt Top


Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following step. The setting triangles on all edges and corners are cut oversized for subsequent trimming.

4 Arrange and stitch 10 diagonal rows using gray/blue 15" quarter-square triangles, blocks, and gray/blue 91/2" squares. You will have 2 quarter-square triangles left over. Sew rows together. Stitch gray/blue 8" half-square triangles to corners. Trim edges

Quilting and Finishing

5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with gray/ blue snowflake print.
